## Certification


Assessment is ongoing by the instructor, a three year qualification will be issued to those who satisfy the criteria.



## Certification



Minimum age of 16, and then it is the employer's responsibility to ensure that the student is suitable for that role. The certificate will expire as dated on the certificate, irrespective of age.


